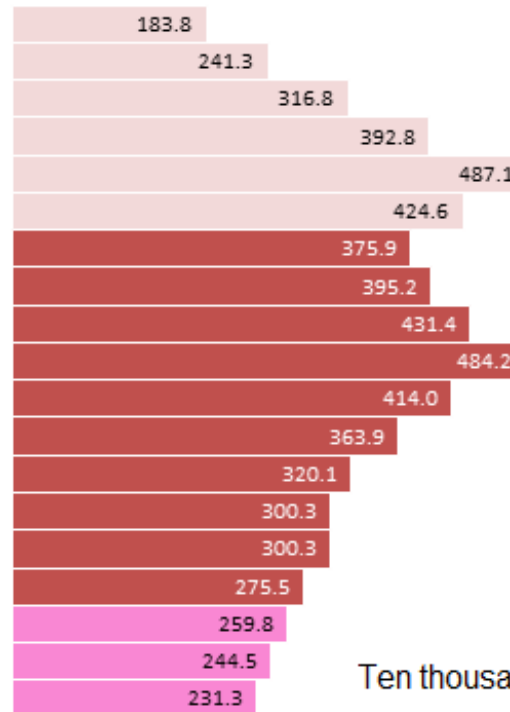

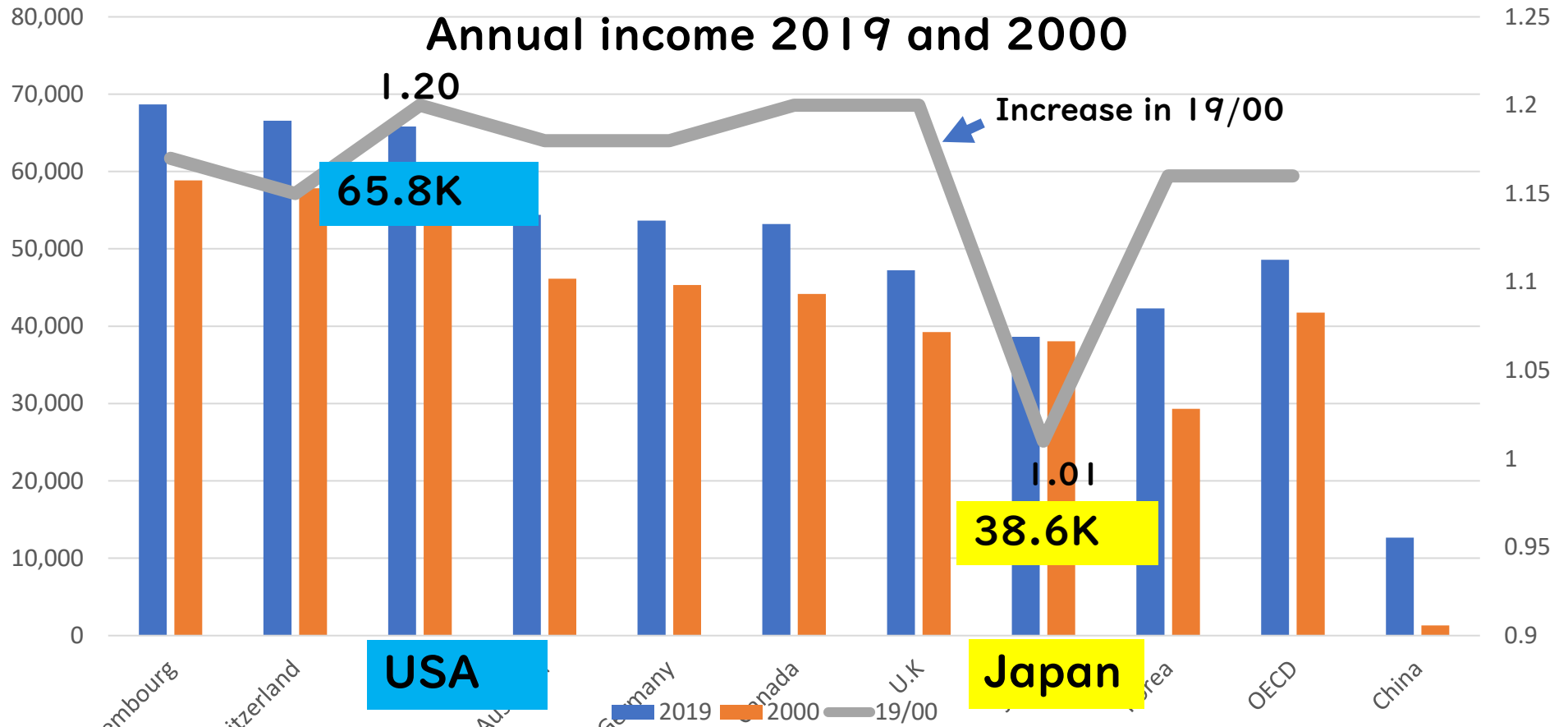

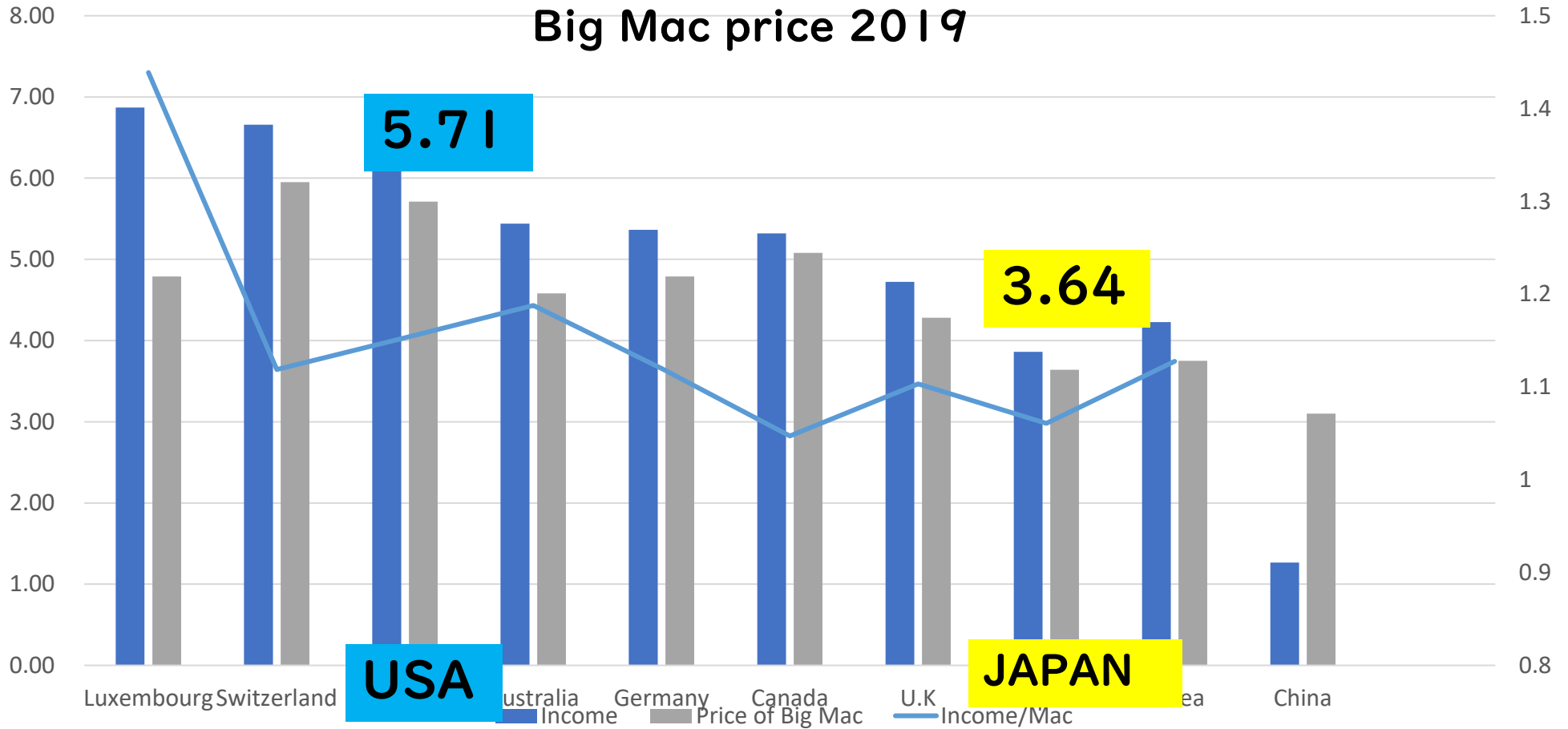

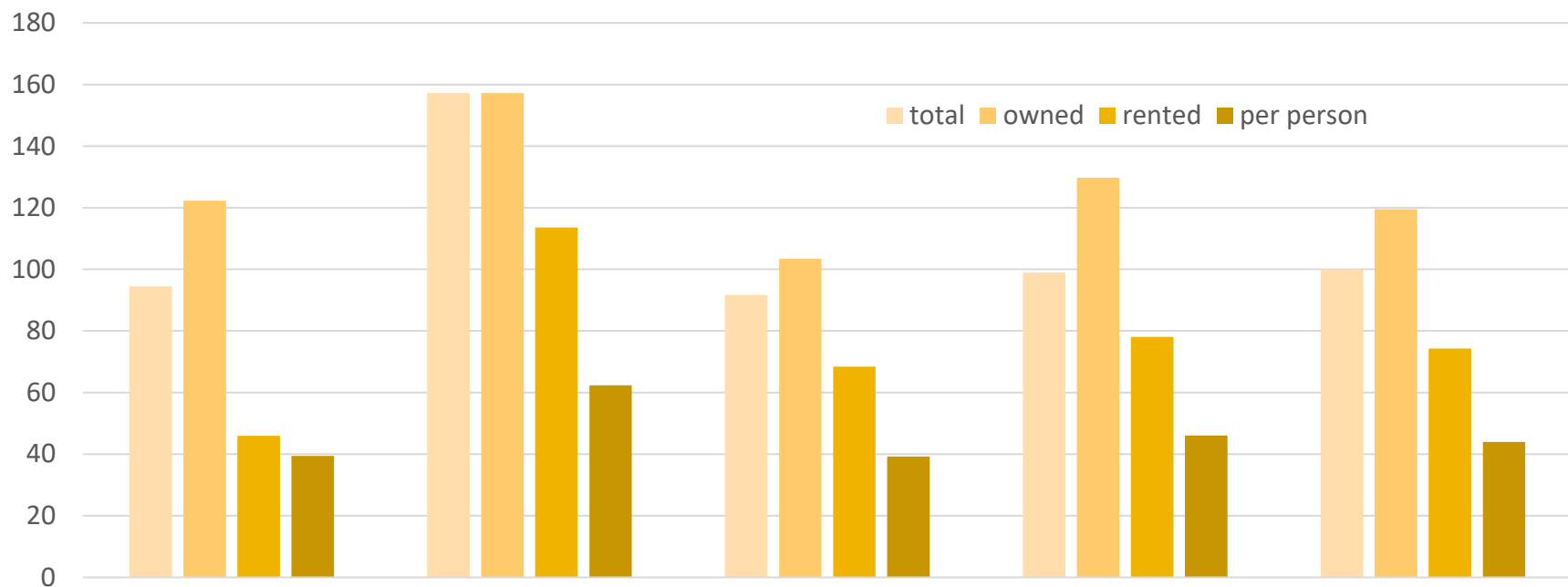

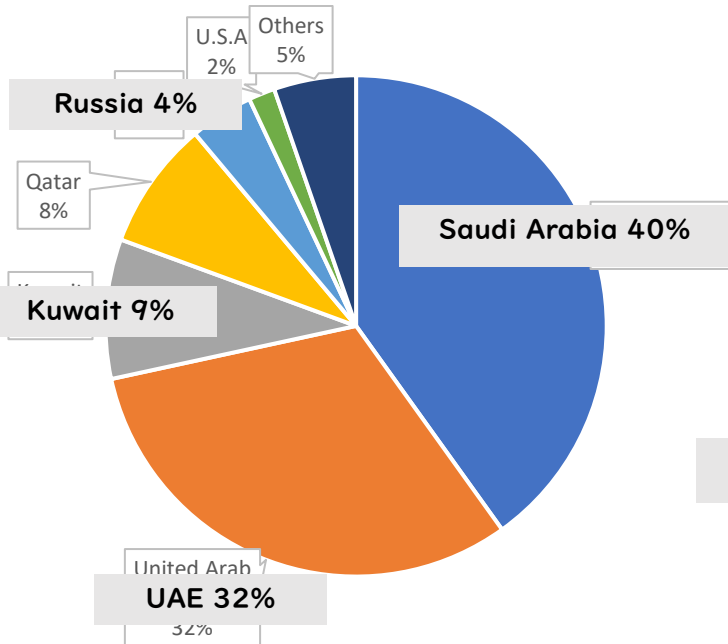

Primary Energy Supply of Japan

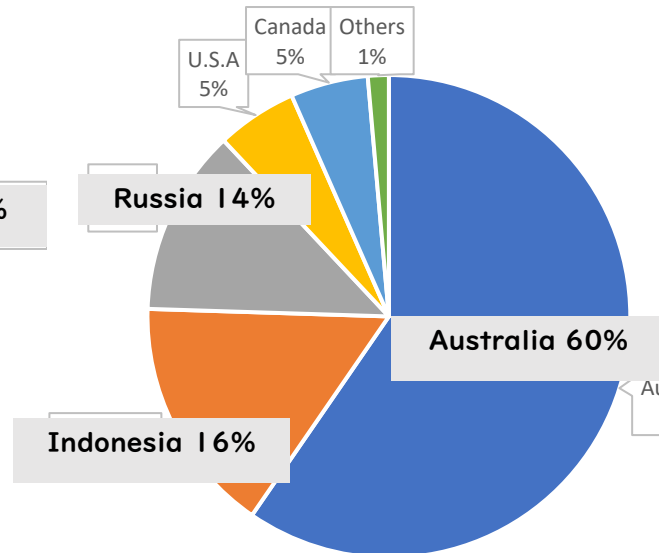

Dependence on foreign countries: **99.7%**



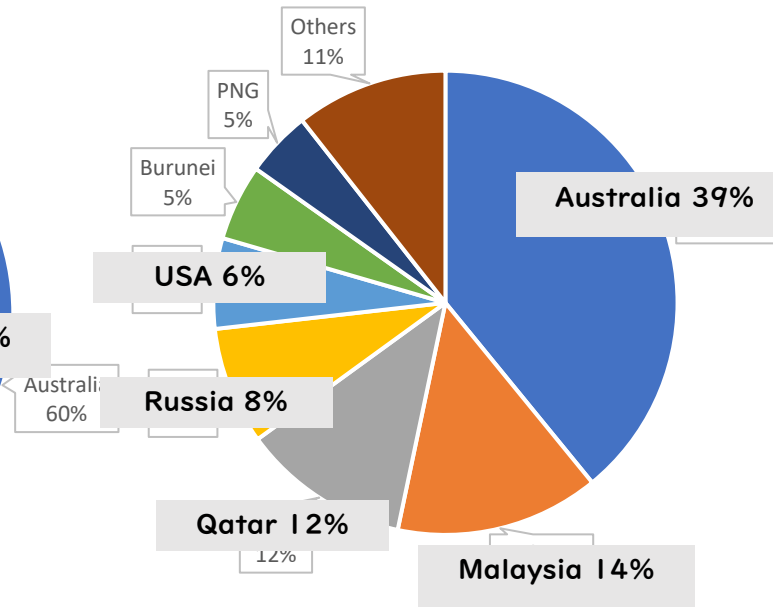
Coal

Dependence on foreign countries: **99.6%**

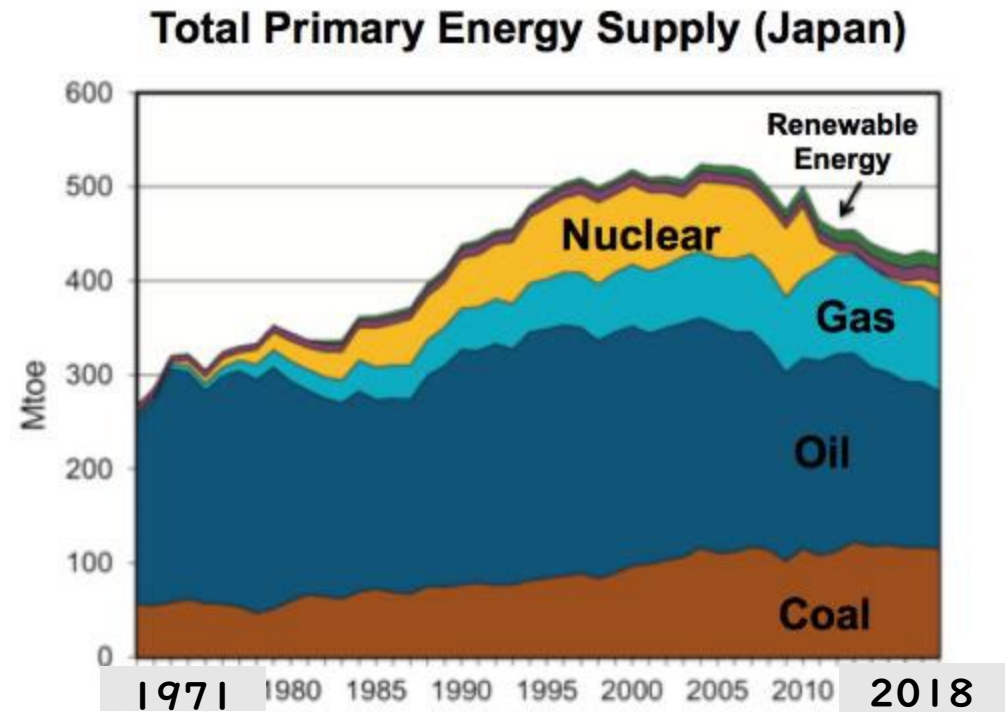
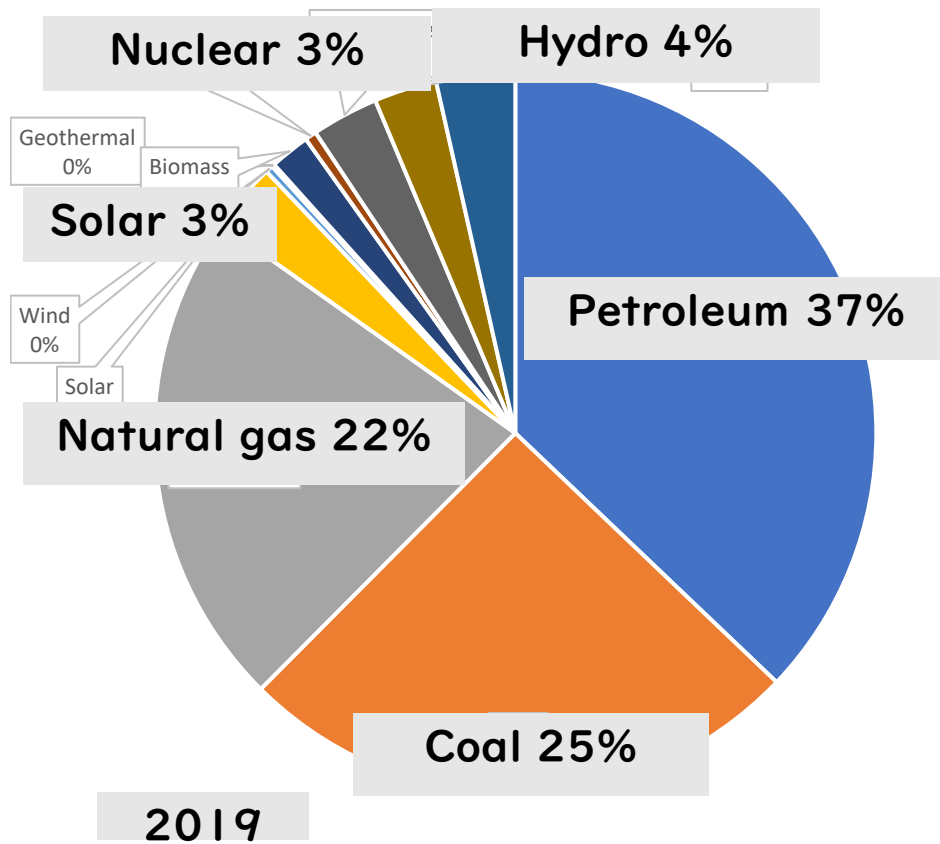

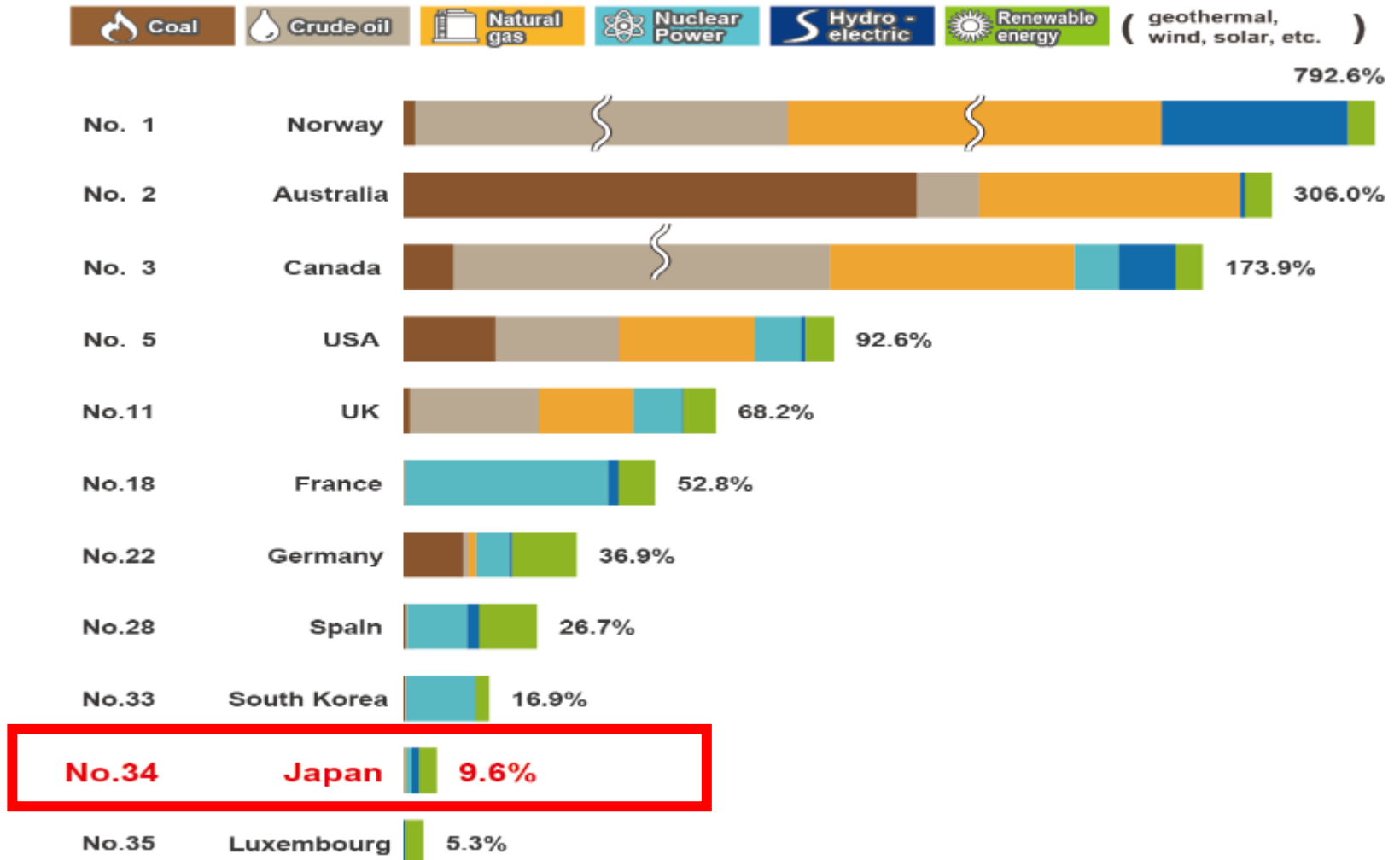
